

Through the GED® testing program adults may receive a high school equivalency at a grade 12 level. The GED® program recognizes that many adults who have not completed a formal high school education may have acquired an educational maturity equal to or above the level of a high school graduate.

GED® credentials are accepted as the equivalent of a high school diploma for the purposes of employment, promotion and licensing. Many Sask Polytechnic and similar programs accept the GED® transcripts in place of a high school transcript as part of a mature student admissions policy.

You need a high school diploma for post-secondary studies or employment requirements and are interested in writing the GED® official exam, an internationally recognized Grade Twelve equivalent, to have your skills recognized.

GED® Testing Information

The GED® tests measure the academic skills and knowledge expected of high school graduates but recognizes skills that may have been acquired outside of the high school setting.

The GED® exam is made up of 5 subject areas: Reading, writing, mathematics, science and social studies. For more information about the GED® program in Saskatchewan go to

Exams are \$7 per module, and testing is available at both campuses. You can write one exam or multiple exams in one sitting.

Create an account at **GED.com** and then contact Meadow Lake Campus when prompted to select an exam time.

TIP: In **GED.com at the top right**, ensure you select "English-Canada" when creating your account.
